

Working with Nature — Our Fruit Forest

Since 2004, Kadoorie Farm & Botanic Garden has adopted agroforestry methods to rejuvenate our aging orchards. We slowly began to convert our traditional single-crop orchards into forest gardens. In our new display “Fruit Forest” located at the lower farm, you can see an orchard where many different types of fruit trees are grown together to produce a better yield of harvest, to improve soil quality and to reduce erosion. In the Fruit Forest, the fruits and herbs can be harvested while nectar from the flowers feed butterflies and honey bees. The opening hours of this new display are from 9:30 am to 4 pm.

森林果園 — 與大自然合作

本園於 2004 年開始採用農林間作方法來活化現有的果園。我們漸漸將種植單一品種的果園轉變為森林果園。於下山區新設的「森林果園」，遊客可以觀察在同一園地混合栽種多種果樹，能提升收成、改善土質和減少泥土侵蝕。果園內的水果和香草可收割食用，而果樹的花蜜則可為蝴蝶和蜜蜂提供食物。森林果園的開放時間：早上 9 時 30 分至下午 4 時。



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
